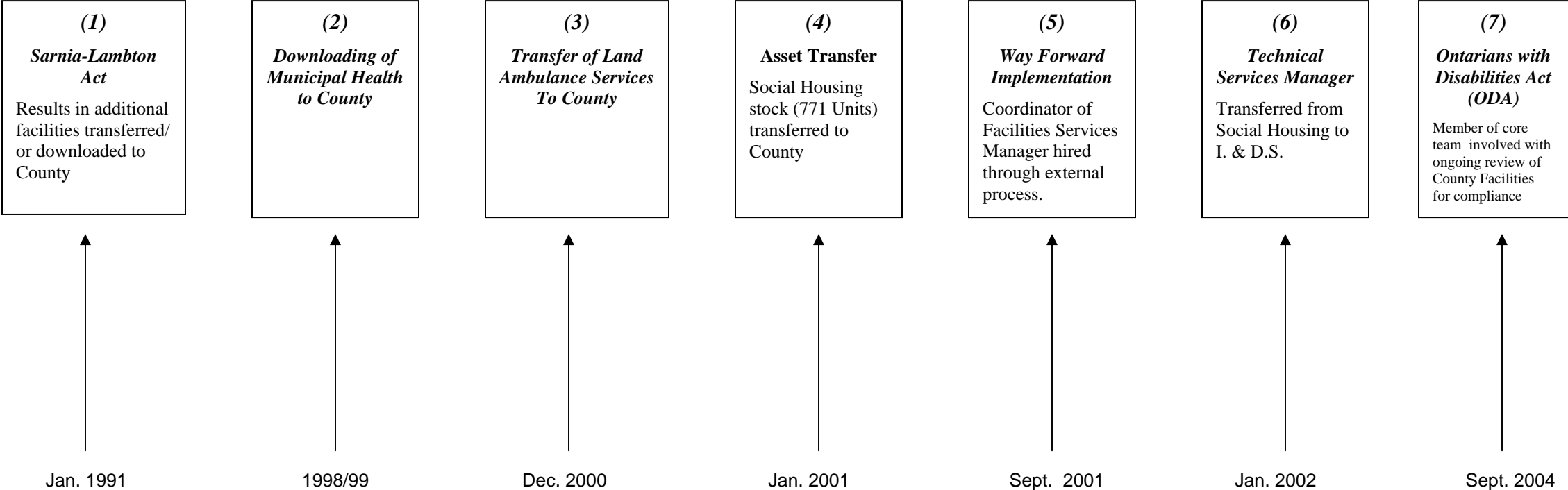

HISTORICAL IMPACTS/REPORTS BACKGROUND

Bill 35 – Sarnia Lambton Act (1)

- The City of Sarnia rejoined the County of Lambton on January 1, 1991.
- Additional facilities transferred to County (i.e. Marshall Gowland Manor, libraries, etc.)
- FTE: 0

Downloading of Municipal Health To County (2)

- Responsibility for additional facility as a result of Provincial download of Lambton Health Unit.

Transfer of Land Ambulance Services to County (3)

- Maintenance of assumed structures and construction of 4 new bases in 2003/04.

Asset Transfer (4)

- Provide maintenance advice and Capital project management related to the transfer of 771 Social housing units having regard to the Capital Reserve and Building Condition Study recommendations
- FTE: 0

Way Forward Initiative (5)

- Facilities Services Department created.
- Coordinator of Facilities Services was hired externally and re-assignment of existing staff. Responsibility for facility maintenance advice to operating departments and capital project management for all new and retro-fit projects across the corporation.
- FTE: 2.0

Technical Services Manager (6)

- Transferred from Social Housing Department to Facilities Services. Main focus remains Social Housing but also assists in other corporate projects as work load dictates.
- FTE: 3.0

Ontarians with Disabilities Act (7)

- Participate as core team member in the County's ongoing review and implementation of the ODA to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Act.
- FTE: 3.0
