

## THE RESEARCH PARK IS GROWING

### New Volunteer Directors Needed for Board

The University of Western Ontario Research Park, Sarnia-Lambton Campus operates in a collaborative, sustainable, entrepreneurial, and principled manner to accelerate innovation and technology based economic development. The Sarnia-Lambton Campus is owned by the County of Lambton Community Development Corporation which is overseen by a Board of Directors that includes senior representatives of the County of Lambton, the City of Sarnia, the University of Western Ontario, and Lambton College. The 80 acre campus is home to a workforce of over 1,500 people and is engaged in a variety of projects of regional and national importance. Over the past years, the Research Park has raised over \$50 million to establish a National Centre of Excellence in Bioindustrial Innovation and to complete significant building renovations and new construction.

The County of Lambton Community Development Corporation is seeking two additional volunteer board members, to expand the Board of Directors. Term of office is up to three years and is expected to be staggered.
