THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF LAMBTON

BY-LAW NO. 28 of 2016

"A By-Law Restricting Weight of Loads on Highways During a Reduced Load Period"

WHEREAS under the authority of s. 122(7) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O., 1990, c. H.8, as amended, council for The Corporation of the County of Lambton (the "County"), being a municipality, may pass a By-Law designating the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the County enacts as follows:

- Sections 122(1), 122(2), 122(3) and 122(4) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O.,
 1990, c. H.8, as amended, shall apply to the highways named in Scheduled
 "A", and outlined in Figure "1" attached hereto during the period from the 1st of
 March, to the 1st day of May, inclusive, in each and every year.
- 2. By-Law No. 40 of 1998 is hereby repealed and replaced by this By-Law. This By-Law supersedes any corresponding By-Law of The Corporation of the County of Lambton which, through inadvertence, may not have been repealed.
- 3. THIS BY-LAW shall come into force upon being passed.
