

**In every home there are products that need special care.  
You will recognize them by these warning signs.**

When you use these hazardous products, you use them carefully. When you don't need them any more, you should dispose of them carefully. That's what Household Hazardous Waste Day is all about - an opportunity to clear potentially hazardous waste out of your home and protect our environment - water, land, and air - at the same time. If hazardous products are thrown in the regular garbage, they can injure sanitation workers and cause long-term environmental problems. Bring your Household Hazardous Waste to the special depot, and it will be dealt with by experts, at no cost to you.

Additionally, in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, event attendees are asked to follow physical distancing protocols, including the following:

1. Package materials in disposable containers (i.e. cardboard boxes) as they will not be returned;
2. Place materials in the trunk or back of their vehicle to maximize distancing for event staff when collecting items; and
3. Remain in their vehicle at all times, as event staff will be removing materials from their vehicle.



**ALSO ACCEPTED:** Sharps (Hypodermic Needles)

**NOT ACCEPTED:** PCB's, commercial, industrial or radioactive wastes, tires, explosives (flares, ammunition), electronics.

**PLEASE NOTE:** For safety reasons, residents are asked to segregate lithium batteries from all other battery types prior to drop-off.
