


WISL NEW JOB SEARCH SITE

Introduced by the Sarnia Lambton Workforce Development Board. Work In Sarnia Lambton is an all-in-one, interactive toolkit for Job Seekers. It includes a job board with postings collected from 23 different job search sites along with a map that geolocated the job opportunities onto a map of the Sarnia Lambton region. Finally, the Regional Census tool shows georeferenced census population data for the various areas of Sarnia Lambton including total population by age group, income level and many other available metrics.

ONLINE APPLICANT TRACKING SYSTEMS

Click here to apply! Apply online today! You see it on all the job search websites. Companies are increasingly encouraging candidates to apply online, but why? The answer is simple - Applicant Tracking Systems (ATS). ATS's are designed to make the hiring process simpler for managers. Key words and phrases will be flagged in the ATS, which will flag applications with those same key words and phrases. ATS's flag the most desirable applications and dismiss all the others.

So how can you make your application stand out from all the rest? Tailor your resume to the position.
